

It is my will and I direct that the said bequest of seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000.00) to my said wife shall be the first charge upon all the property, both real and personal, comprising my estate and must be paid in full before any other legacies or bequests are paid hereunder, and in case the assets of my estate shall not be of sufficient value to pay in full my debts, costs of administration, the said sum of seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000.00) and all the other legacies and bequests herein given, then I direct and it is my will that the said legacy of seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000.00) to my said wife shall be paid in full and all other legacies and bequests herein given shall abate proportionately. If my wife should predecease me or should in whole die in the hands of a common accident or disaster and there should be no issue of my survivor, then the said sum of seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000.00) shall be applied to increase, to the extent the legacies which shall be payable under the provisions of Clause F of the hereof.

I give and bequeath to the following named persons the following amounts:

- (a) To my sister Anna Grace Greer of Bayville in the County of Antigonish, Province of Nova Scotia, Dominion of Canada, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00);
- (b) To my sister Emma Williams of West River, in the County of Antigonish, Province of Nova Scotia, Dominion of Canada, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00);
- (c) To my sister Florence Graham of the Town of Antigonish, in the County of Antigonish, Province of Nova Scotia, Dominion of Canada, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00);
- (d) To my nephew Edwin Gordon MacDonnell of James River, in the County of Antigonish, Province of Nova Scotia, Dominion of Canada,

- The sum of one Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)
- (e) To my nephew Robert MacDonnell of James River in the County of Antigonish, Province of Nova Scotia, Dominion of Canada the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00)
 - (f) To my niece Mary Grace Donald Williams of James River in the County of Antigonish, Province of Nova Scotia, Dominion of Canada, the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00)
 - (g) To my niece Eva Grace Donald of James River in the County of Antigonish, Province of Nova Scotia, Dominion of Canada the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00)
 - (h) To my niece Margaret Grace Donald Rose of Winkipog, Province of Canada, the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00)
(The last mentioned four persons are all children of my deceased sister Mary Grace Donald)
 - (i) To my nephew Clifford Lathelau (son of my deceased brother Hugh Lathelau) of St Albans Maine U.S.A. the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)
 - (j) To my nephew Eugene Cameron (son of my deceased sister Jenn Cameron) of Salt Spring, Antigonish County, Nova Scotia, the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00)
- If any of the legatees mentioned in Paragraphs (a) to (j) inclusive, in this clause should predecease me and leave issue or surviving, such issue shall take the legacy herein bequeathed to said parent in equal shares ~~with the parent~~
- So that all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, and wherever situated, including any property over-
